### THE ALMIGHTY'S HOUSE OF IVRIYAH

A Service Sisterhood Aleph House 2022

### Introduction

The Almighty's House of Ivriyah is a global service sisterhood. The Almighty's House of Ivriyah requires that its sisters exemplify and epitomize the moral, personal, public, private, and cultural standards of the Proverbial Woman described in Proverbs [Mishlei] 31.

The Almighty's House of Ivriyah ("The House") has a zero - tolerance hazing policy. The policy expressly prohibits all acts and forms of hazing, before, during, and after the Sisterhood Intake Process.

The House Code of Conduct consists of four parts: (1) the Code of Ethics (2) Programs, Bible Studies, & Extra Curriculars, which depicts the type(s) of conduct that the The House considers appropriate, (3) The Ivriyah Declaration, and (4) Code of Correction, "The Rod", which states the disciplinary action for Code of Conduct violations.

### Code of Ethics

Believing in equity, restoration, and unification of the human race, The House expects each sister to recognize and uphold our cardinal virtues of ambition, sisterhood, wisdom, modesty, humility, righteousness, and charity. Each sister is expected to live our virtues by edifying and adhering to the following ethical codes:

### Programs, Bible Studies, & Extracurriculars

Members and participants are strictly prohibited from promoting personal agendas, engaging in religious rhetoric, or attempting to impose doctrinal beliefs on others.

Our discussions and interactions should remain centered on healing, community building, and collective action to address the challenges faced by our nation.

Only authorized individuals, with consent from the United Nation of Yisrael's elder and executive bodies, are allowed to conduct programs and Bible studies within The Almighty's House platforms.

The focus of these authorized programs should be on unifying the 12 tribes of Yisrael and working towards the restoration of our nation.

If approved, you must create and share an agenda and curriculum with your Bible study to be shared any time you share a link to it. We also ask that you remind your attendees of your agenda and what you plan to talk about at the beginning of each study.

If you decide to carry on with independent bible studies, neither you nor any AHOI member acting on your behalf may distribute information or links within official UNY/AHOI channels.

While we do support nation-building, which includes fostering fellowship among brothers and sisters, we do not endorse doctrinal discussions and groups created either within or outside the United Nation of Yisrael's or Almighty's House platforms. The reason is straightforward: our primary focus is on nation-building, not religious rhetoric. We are not affiliated with any church or religious institution. We are aware that religion has often been used to divide us.

If you happen to find yourself in such a chat or group, whether on our platforms or elsewhere, that promotes a particular doctrinal belief over another or if you come across anything that seems intended to create

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division among us, we highly recommend that you remove yourself from such a group or chat. Such activities do not align with our shared purpose, which is NATION BUILDING.

We adhere strictly to our zero-tolerance policy regarding division. All programs, bible studies, chats, etc., hosted or promoted on AHOIs platforms must receive prior approval from the The Executive AHOI Council and the United Nation of Yisrael Organizational Leadership. Any unauthorized programs will be promptly removed, and individuals responsible for them will also face removal.

If you are found responsible for creating groups outside the AHOI or The United Nation of Yisrael's platforms and engaging with constituents of the United Nation of Yisrael or members of AHOI in a manner that fosters division, divisiveness, insurrection, or anything contrary to our shared goal of gathering and nation-building, you will be expelled from our platforms and barred from attending our meetings until further notice.

This Scriptural Breakdown of the Ivriyah Declaration will help the reader understand the importance and intention of the chosen characteristics from the Official Ivriyah Declaclaration:

Code of Correction The Rod

The Rod Code of Correction sets forth the consequences of unacceptable, inappropriate and prohibited conduct of sisters and applicants. Such inappropriate conduct is subject to suspension or exile from The House.

Suspensions and exiles are designed to address the consequences of a house, a sister, or an applicant, engaging in inappropriate and prohibited conduct. Behaviors and conduct that violate a state or federal law may result in consequences beyond those outlined in The Rod.

Having discernment on effectively identifying, managing, and resolving conflict versus exercising The Rod is paramount for healthy interpersonal relationships in Local Houses. There may be instances of interpersonal disputes (e.g. change, ineffective order, poor communication, poor processes/procedures, etc) that do not need to be escalated as an infraction of The Rod. Sources of conflict within the house bases and among sisters that cannot be resolved internally should be transferred to the Aleph House for conflict resolution, intervention and management.

Any sister or applicant shall be flagged, suspended or exiled from the sisterhood at any point in the process in which The House discovers, through any means, that the sister or applicant has participated in behavior or activities at any point, that would, as determined by the The House in its sole discretion, defame the sisterhood or disparage its name, order, reputation, respect or goodwill; or are inconsistent with the characteristics of the Ivriyah Declaration.

As provided in the Constitution and Bylaws and specified in detail in this Code of Conduct, sisters and House bases may be placed on probation, suspended, or exiled from The House by the Aleph House, or the Aleph House President for engaging in prohibited conduct or activities. Sisters and House bases on probation will not participate in any activity of The House, except specified, monitored activities approved by the Aleph House and appropriate committees. To be eligible for reinstatement, a sister or a house base must satisfy all financial and rehabilitation obligations as prescribed by the Aleph House and its appropriate committees.
